



# St Mary's RC Primary School

## Sports Premium Plan 2022-23

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### Overview

Last academic year, the school received £17,803 Sports Premium funding which is set aside for developing sport, exercise and health across the school. The school carried forward £6,455 from the previous year's allocation making £24,258 in total. The funding this year has been allocated on:

The school spent £25,147 on sports over the past year.

- Gateshead Schools Sports Partnership and additional coaching (£5,230).
- Participation in the Gateshead Healthy School programme (£575)
- Updating PE equipment (£7835)
- Storage (£3584)
- Sports Kit (£2248)
- Additional swimming provision (£2,250)
- Transportation to/from sports events (£3,425)

The school spent its allocation of Sports Premium funding within the year.

### School Sports Priorities

School priorities for sport are as follows:

1. Sporting participation:
  - All pupils will represent the school in at least one inter-school competition.
  - The school will aim for representation in all GSSP events.
  - The school will use GSSP coaching to upskill staff and ensure wider confidence in participation from all pupils (not just those who attend clubs outside of school).
  - Ensure resources and equipment are up to date and well used across the PE Curriculum.
  - Clubs/extra-curricular at lunchtime and after school.
  - Two classes to attend swimming lessons for full year – go beyond National Curriculum expectations.
2. Health and well-being:
  - Plan for whole-school events to promote active play during pupil breaktimes.
  - Sports lead to attend relevant training through Gateshead Healthy Schools.
  - Engage with families where children are lacking activity outside of school.
  - Ensure participation from all pupils.
  - Ensure all pupils have access to resources during break times.

3. Inclusion:
  - Ensure participation on inclusive sporting events.
  - Ensure participation from all pupils.
  - Use funds to purchase – where required – specialised resources to ensure inclusivity.
4. Sporting Achievement:
  - To achieve Platinum in the School Games Mark.
  - To ensure that pupils have the opportunity to participate in local, regional and national finals in a number of events.
5. Swimming:
  - Before they leave KS2, ensure that all pupils meet Curriculum expectations to:
    - swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
    - use a range of strokes effectively, for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke
    - perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

## Evaluation of 2021-22

We have used specialist coaches across the whole school to give all of our children a broad and balanced curriculum and a taste of a variety of activities and sports aimed at developing active lifestyles.

### Inter-School Events 2021-2022

Our aim is to give every child in the school, from Year 1 to Year 6, the opportunity to represent the school on at least one occasion every year. We were very happy to have the opportunity to compete in inter-school events again this year, which had been greatly affected during the COVID pandemic. We have had a very successful sporting year and many of the SSP and Cluster events have led to next stages, local and County finals. This year, some of our children have had the opportunity of dancing on the stage at The Sage Gateshead, running on the track at Gateshead Stadium and representing Gateshead in Netball and Swimming finals.

### Swimming

Two classes, Year 4 and Year 5, have had swimming provision for the whole academic year. This was decided due to time lost during the COVID pandemic when local swimming pools were closed for long periods of time. This has proved very successful and children have become competent swimmers and have also learned life-saving skills. The

Year 5 swimmers came second in the Gateshead Inter-School competition and then represented Gateshead in the South of Tyne finals.

100% of pupils in Y6 have met national curriculum expectations in swimming.
