



## SCHOOL UPDATES

### END OF TERM:

On Wednesday, we celebrated a wonderfully reflective and prayerful whole school Liturgy at St Mary's Church: a culmination of our Lenten journey in school and a fitting segue in to Holy Week. Over the past six weeks, we have come together as a school community in prayer, reflection and positive action; our pupils have been involved in: various creative prayer opportunities, an incredibly successful Mission Week, sponsored activities raising money for two very special charities (St Cuthbert's Care and The Ukweli Home for Hope) and a food appeal for a local shelter for the homeless. It has been a thoroughly invigorating time to be in school, and I'm so proud of the efforts of our pupils and wider community this Lenten season.

The theme we have been following this Lent, taking inspiration from Blessed Oscar Romero, is 'Be God's Microphone'. As well as shouting out about our faith in action, we've also had plenty of other things to make noise about. Pupils have been working incredibly hard in class, and some wonderful progress has been seen across school, from our youngest pupils in Reception Class – who now act as though they've been here forever – to our most senior pupils in Year 6, who have been applying themselves admirably in preparation for their SATs assessments in May.

As well as our in-class exploits, pupils have also benefitted from a vast array of extended learning and extra-curricular opportunities. Sport has again been high on the agenda, with Badminton and Rugby League being offered in Years 4 and 6 to augment the Physical Education already on offer at school. Pupils have competed in a number of sporting events, from the Gateshead Skipping and Dance Festivals, to Quick-sticks hockey and Multi-skills, and a number of our sporting teams have celebrated great success this term: notably, the school football team who have qualified locally for finals of the Blaydon and District League, and (quite impressively) for the finals of the National League Schools Cup which will take place at Wembley Stadium in May, as well as the Hi-5 Netball squad who recently competed in the county finals. Our Coast to Coast team in Year 5 have also stepped up their training in earnest, completing rides of up to 20km (and lots of hills!) in preparation for their ride in June – quite some feat I'm sure you'll agree – and all pupils have again benefitted from outdoor learning opportunities, working on various projects including the planting of our school allotment (which is coming on marvelously).

Further to this, Music and the Arts have once more been a highlight; we have enjoyed the first performance of our Year 4 String Orchestra, and our school choir continues to go from strength to strength. We have a budding team of Arts Ambassadors in school who are working towards receiving 'Arts Award' recognition, and there have been numerous class trips and visitors to school to enthuse learners and make learning real for our pupils.

All in all, it's been an almost breathless Spring Term, and we don't anticipate that there will be any let-up in the Summer. As a school staff, we've loved being part of such a successful start to 2017, and we look forward to sharing continued successes and celebrations with you in the term to come. Have a restful and holy Easter, and I look forward to seeing you all back at school on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April.
