- Tickets are limited and will be sold on a first come, first served basis. Tickets are strictly limited, so please act quickly to avoid disappointment.
- To maximise ticket availability for as many parents/carers as possible, organisers are stipulating a purchase limit of 2 tickets per child in the first instance. This is reflected by purchase limits in place on the Glasshouse International Centre for Music website.
- Tickets are priced at £8.00 (standard rate) and £5.50 (concessions under 16s, 60+ and unwaged).
- E-tickets are now in place as standard for this event e-tickets will be emailed directly to those making a purchase.
